Questions submitted after this deadline will not be considered during the meeting, but a written response will be prepared and, where possible, published via the [NHS Cheshire and Merseyside website](#).

We kindly request that questions are relevant to the meeting agenda.

Every effort will be made to include and answer as many public questions as possible at each meeting, however time dedicated to answering questions will need to be balanced with the time needed for considering all items on the meeting agenda. Priority will be given to those questions that are relevant to the items on the agenda. All questions that are not addressed in the Board meeting will be followed up with a written response.

If a response to a question requires information to be collated that is not readily available or possible in advance of the meeting, then we will ensure that a written response is provided.
